RJLOCKDOWN / RJ45 Patch Cord Lock

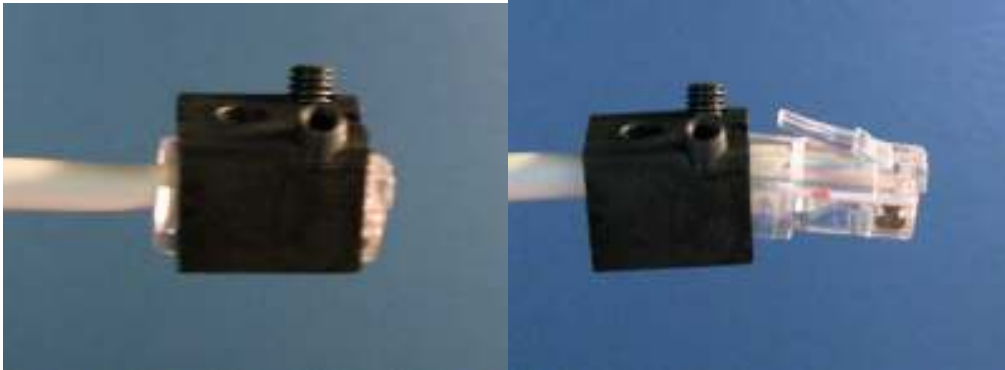

1. Some patch chords have boots that cover the clip. You might have to cut the boot off for the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock to work. This will ensure that the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock can slide over the plug and underneath the clip. (Image 2)
2. Before you slide the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock on, make sure the set screws are not sticking through the inside.
3. Now thread the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock onto the patch cord. (Image 1)
4. Slide the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock completely over the plug. (Image 2)
5. Then secure the plug into the RJ45 jack, and slide the RJ45 Patch Cord Lock under the clip of the plug.
6. Tighten the set screws into place and the RJ45 patch cord is secure. (Image 3)

*Note: There are three holes incase the patch cord has a cord relief, so you can use the center one instead of the side holes.
